

3rd FAI Woman's World Championships- Naleczow, Poland- August 5th, 2018 Evening Flight

Synopsis: Gusty winds are expected to gradually decrease this evening as surface inversion sets up. Thunderstorms associated with a cold front moving through the region are mainly expected to be to the south and east of Naleczow, through the evening hours. Northwest to southeast flow will prevail for the next 24 hours, but could be a bit breezy.
