

3rd FAI Woman's World Championships- Naleczow, Poland- August 6th AM

Synopsis: Winds from the northwest will prevail throughout the day today. Surface winds will become gusty after 730 am, the right will go away and the overall direction will settle on a 300-305 line (from) as the surface warms above 18 C. Gusts up to 13 kts (14 mph) will be likely through much of the day.
